Gutter clearance checklist

- Clean all the gutters, including any valley and parapet gutters
- Clean and remove debris from any rainwater hoppers or sumps
- Check that all the gutters are secure and free from leaks
- Clean all the down-pipes and check that they are secure and free from leaks
- Clean out the above ground gullies and drainage channels
- Check the condition of the manholes and inspection chambers
- Check the drains and ensure that they are clear; rod if necessary
- Remove any rubbish or waste from site
- Kill and then remove any vegetation growing in, on or next to the building
- Identify and note any defects in building fabric
- Take "before" and "after" photographs to show what has been done and to identify any defects or urgent problems
